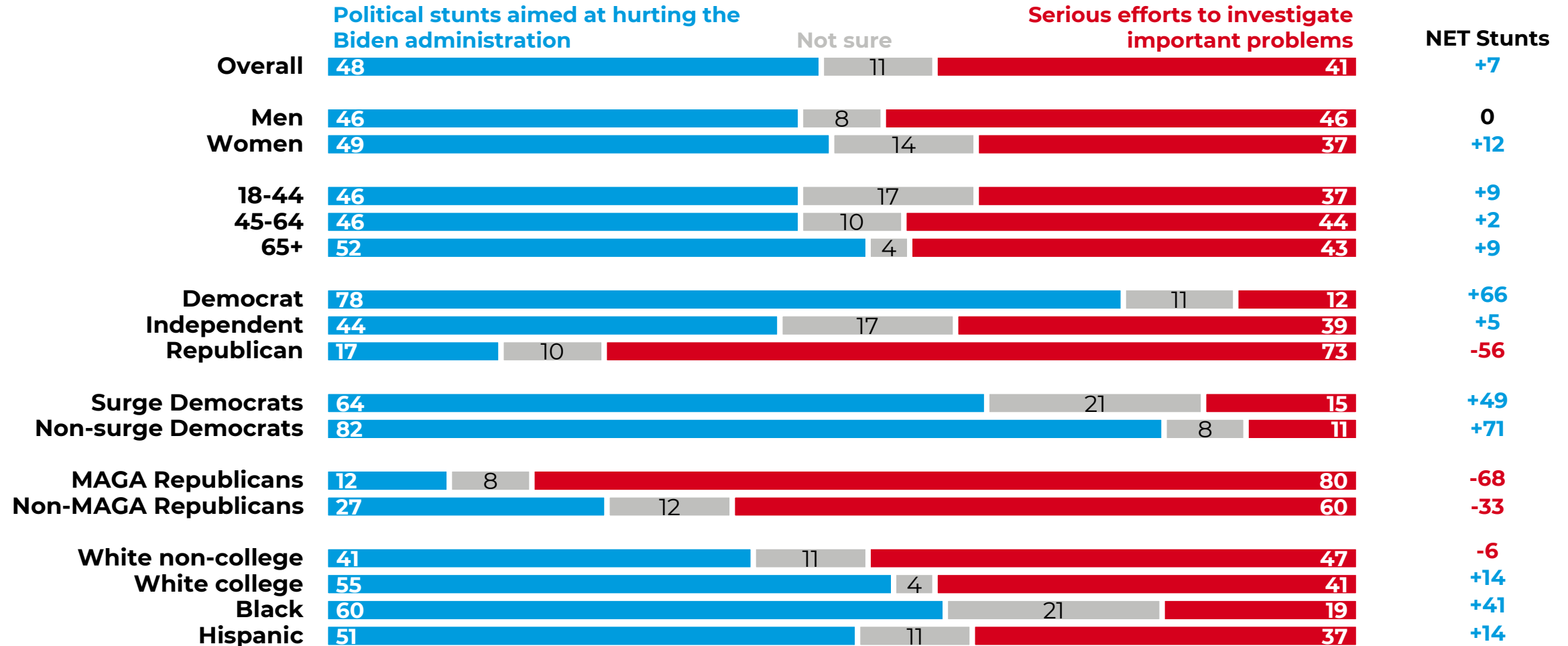

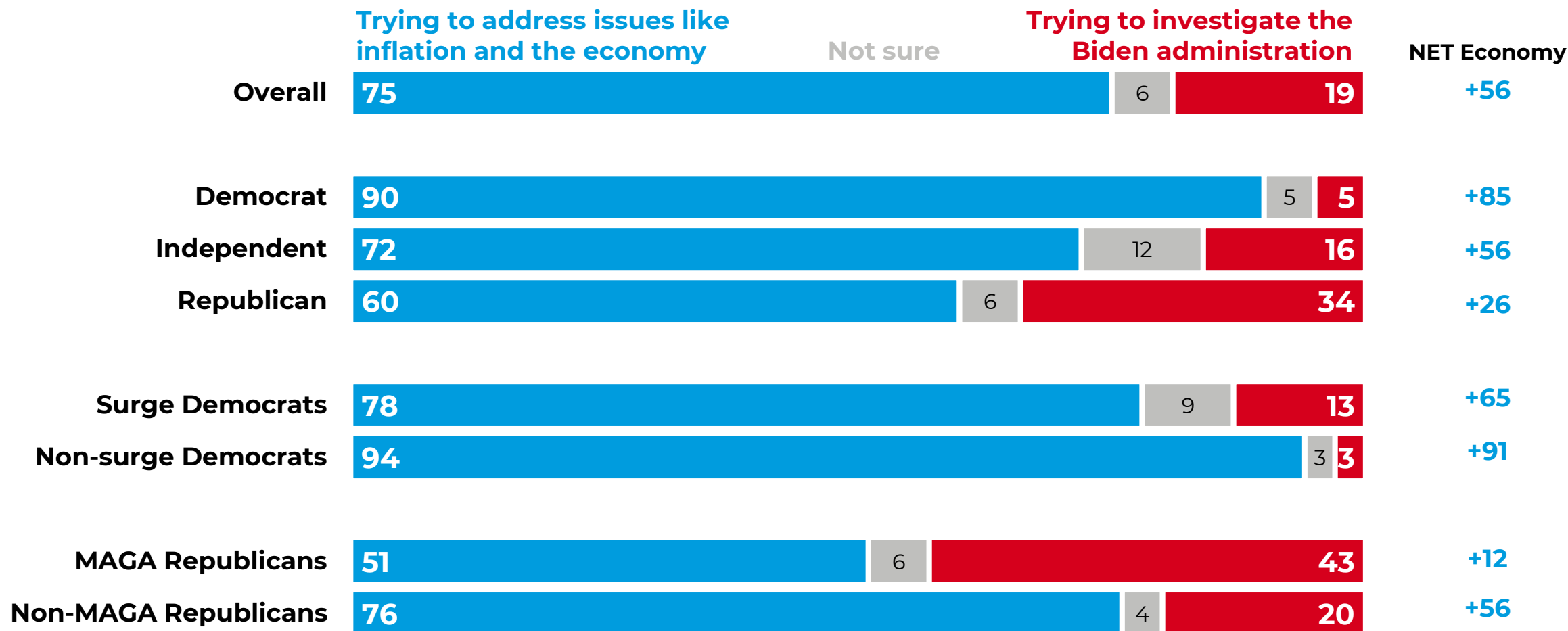
Voters are more likely to consider the investigations stunts than serious efforts

And in general, do you think these investigations are more likely to be...



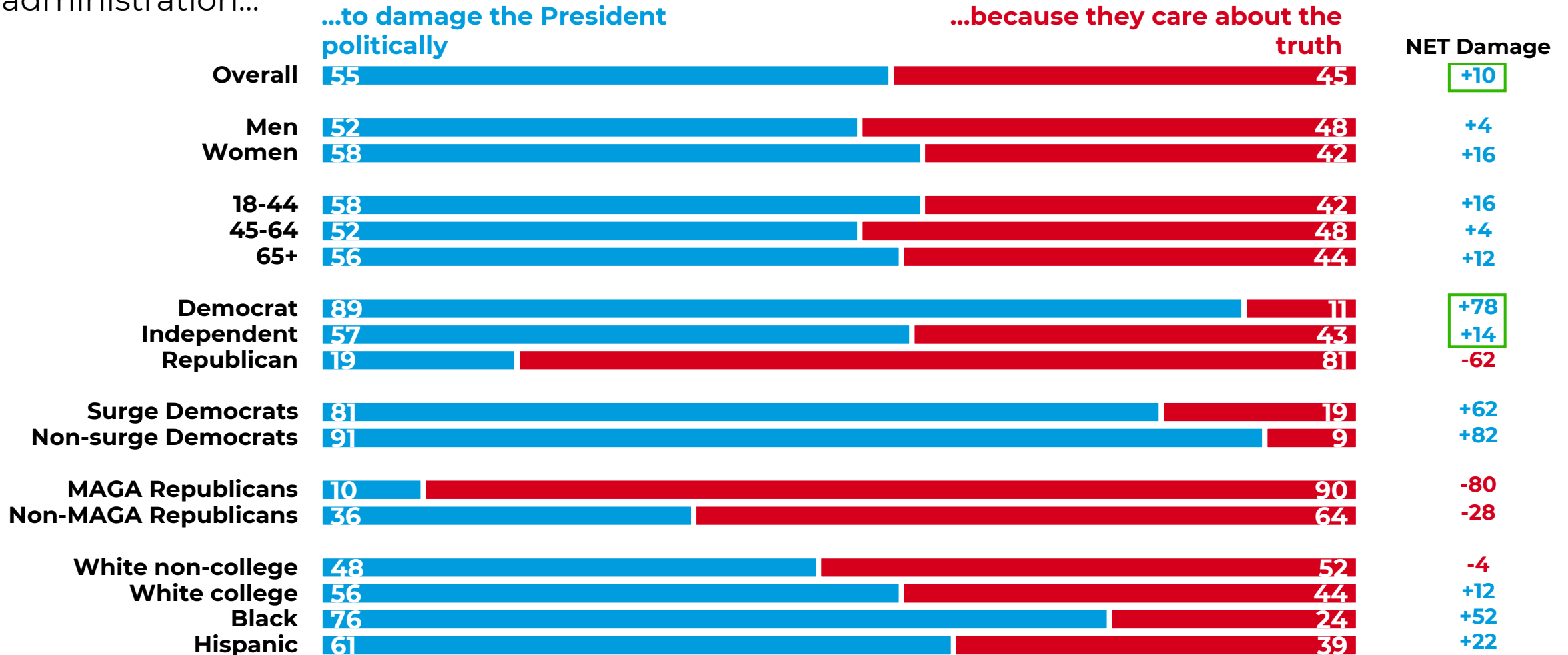
Voters continue to want Republicans in Congress to focus more on the economy than investigations, including a large majority of non-MAGA Republicans

What do you think Republicans in Congress should focus more on?



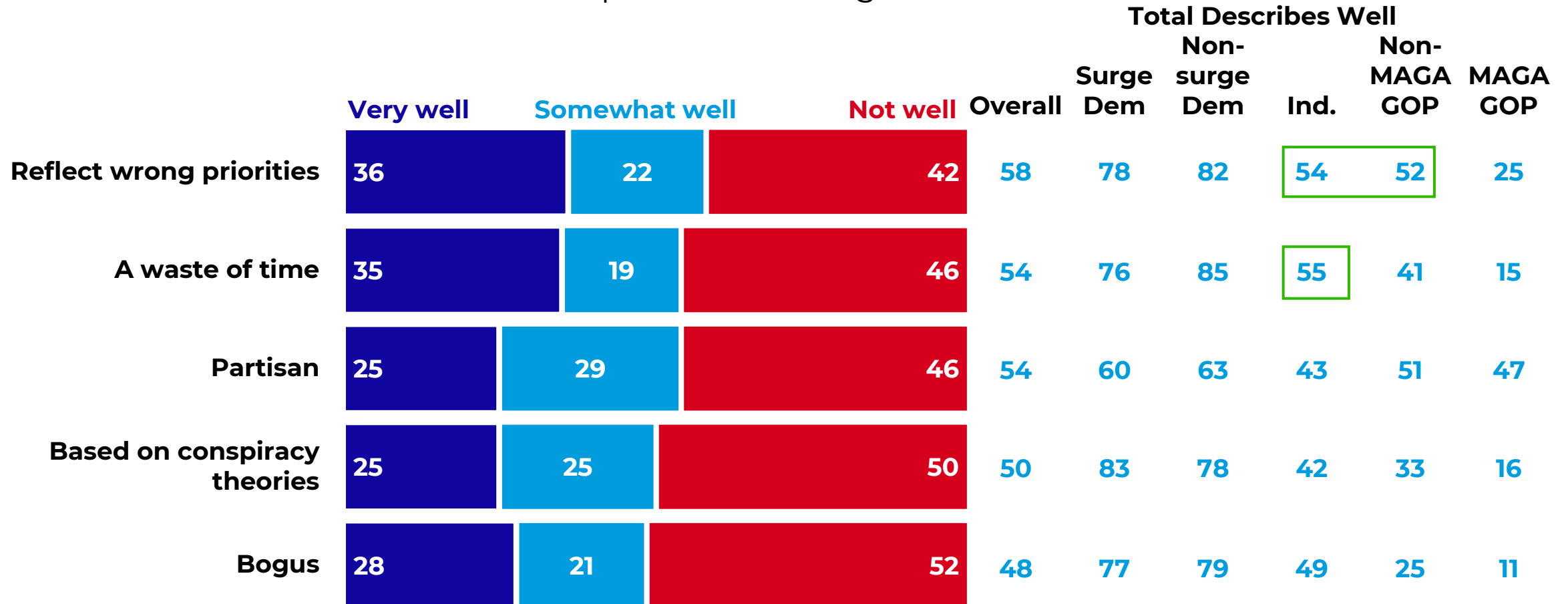
Voters are more likely to believe the investigations are intended to damage Biden than find the truth
